LOCATION:

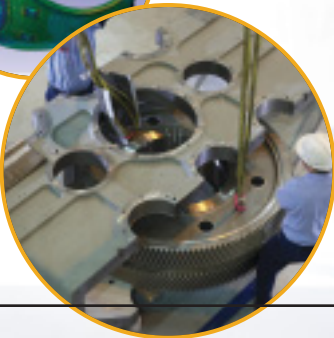
The Iowa City area sits at the crossroads of Interstates I-80 and I-380.
